Additional Jazz Class:

New for 2017 is an additional jazz class. This class is for students who have already completed at least one year of band in school. **This class is NOT for beginners.** Students in the jazz class will meet 8:15-9:00AM each day. Students in the jazz portion will receive a book and music. The fee for the extra class is \$75.

Instrument Rental:

Students new to band will need to rent an instrument. The quality of instrument is paramount in the success of your student in band. Please consult your schools policy on brands of instruments that are acceptable. We highly recommend renting from a reputable source and getting a warranty. If you purchase an instrument, PLEASE consult your band director FIRST. There are many things that look like instruments, but are not acceptable quality. Your student will not succeed if they don't have a proper equipment. We recommend contacting multiple stores to inquire about their rental prices/agreements.
