

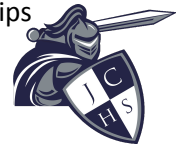

Reports of Officers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● President ● Secretary: Motion to approve the September 11, 2019 meeting minutes ● Treasurer: Presentation of September bank balances ● VP Operations ● VP Logistics ● Guard Representative <p>Minutes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● JK Moving Pep Rally. Played stand tunes. Band was featured on the Tommy Show. Download his app to listen to his podcast. ● Home Games. After the football game against Osborne Park, we invited their band to play after the game. Our students cheered them on from the stands! ● German Exchange Program. Six joined us and played in the Pep Band in Annapolis and watched from the stands during the competition at the Naval Academy. ● U.S. Bands Naval Competition. We won 2nd place overall out of 12 bands and 1st place in our division. ● 8th Grade Side by Side on 10/4. Will play together on the field. Total 430 students. Need volunteers to serve pizza and stay afterwards to talk to the parents who might have questions about Marching Band next year. ● BOA Mid Atlantic. Will be an all-day event, leaving at 9am, staying for entire competition to listen to all the bands. Need volunteers when they return to unload the trucks and get the uniforms in order. ● Homecoming Football Game on Oct 11. Band plays after the game. ● Marching Assessment @ Rock Ridge HS and JMU Parade of Champions on 10/19. Will eat at JMU dining hall on campus, so the students will need to bring cash (may pre-pay it). ● BOA Liberty University Competition on 10/26. Will be a very long day as well. Will send message when leave Liberty and when back at Champe. ● September Minutes. Sent via email. Motion to approve by Dallas Cecil; second by Andrea Carroll. Unanimously approved. ● Bank Balances. \$44k in the bank. After pay for buses to Liberty \$11k, will have \$33k. ● Operations Update. Built 64 square foot platform in the trailer. Created a load out plan that is posted on the back gate and inside of the trailer to document where items should be placed when volunteering. Lightridge High School Update</p> <p><i>Minutes:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr. Ryan Hitchman, Principal of Lightridge High School (LHS) and Barbara Plunkett joined the meeting. • Background. Dr. Hitchman previously served at Belmont Ridge HS and prior in Blacksburg and St. Mary's County in many teaching and administrator roles. He lives in Brambleton. He is originally from La Trobe near Pittsburgh, PA. He values the fine arts and live music. • Grandfather Rising Senior Siblings. Families with a rising Senior, their siblings in 9th and 10th grade will have the option to be grandfathered to remain at Champe. In early November, families will receive a survey from Planning and Facilities asking for determination of whether plan to attend Champe or transition to LHS. Survey due back by end of the month. Budget will be based on survey selections. • Mascot. Will unveil the LHS Mascot soon based on voting by Champe and Willard students this week and next. • Staffing. Will post for Department Chairs in November, conduct interviews in December, and hiring in January. Intend to hire a Band Director at LHS. Hosting a Booster interest meeting tomorrow. • Programs. Have been working with the band directors to plan for band resources at LHS. LHS will have a Varsity Program in the Fall 2020 as 3A.
